

Incoming Student Scholarship Application Worksheet


This form is not the actual application, but a worksheet provided to help you prepare to complete the online form. Use it to prepare, and then complete and submit the form online.

All of the information requested on this form is required in order to assure your full consideration for all eligible scholarships. To be considered for scholarships that take need into account you must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). The preferred filing date for Illinois State University is November 15. The FAFSA can be completed online at www.fafsa.ed.gov.

Applications must be submitted by Friday, February 9, 2018.

You must be a freshman or transfer student accepted into an IT major for Fall 2018 to receive these scholarships and you must remain an IT major and may need to remain in a specific major and/or sequence to receive a scholarship, depending on the scholarship requirements. Each scholarship has specific criteria which may include academic merit, school and community involvement, financial need and/or enrollment in a specific major or sequence.

All School Scholarships will be announced to the recipients in the spring and presented at the School of Information Technology Scholarship Recognition Event in Fall 2018. Scholarship donors will be on hand for the scholarship presentations and students selected to receive scholarships are required to attend. Students receiving scholarship will be required to attend any special events hosted by the scholarship donor. Students receiving scholarships will be expected to send a formal thank you note to the scholarship donor. The School will help facilitate the thank you.
