Eligibility:

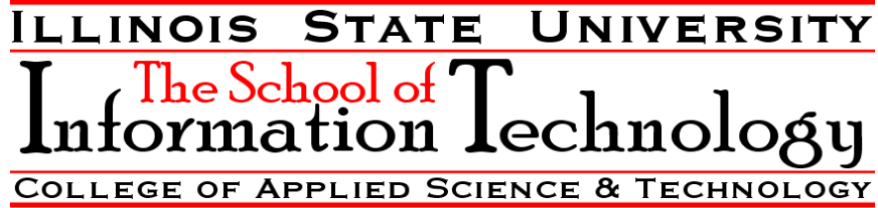
The School of Information Technology graduate awards are limited. **Only students currently enrolled as graduate students planning to graduate in May, August, or December of the coming year are eligible to apply.**
